

- A candidate belonging to the NRI / PIO / FN category is not required to appear for the entrance examination.
- An NRI is a person who is not a resident or who is not ordinarily resident. A person is treated as not ordinarily resident (i) if he/she has been resident in India for less than 182 days in the year preceding the date of application; or (ii) If he/she has been in India for less than 365 days during the four years immediately preceding date of application.
- A PIO is a person having foreign citizenship (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) within NRI status, but who holds a foreign passport at the time of sending application or at the time of consideration of admission and during the period of his study and whose one / both parents or anyone/both grandparents is (or was) / are (or were) citizen(s) of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Section 2(b) of Citizenship Act 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).
- An FN is a person having citizenship of a foreign country and not having the status NRI and/ or PIO.
- Included as 15% of overall sanctioned intake.
- ** Over and above the approved intake of the seats for a particular programme. As notified by UGC vide D.O.No. I-1/2022(CPP-II), dated 30-09-2022(Point No.3). An FN is a person having citizenship of a foreign country (country other than India) and not having the status of 'NRI' and or 'PIO'.
