- A PIO is a person having foreign citizenship (except Pakistan and Bangladesh) within NRI status, but who holds a foreign passport at the time of sending application or at the time of consideration of admission and during the period of his study and whose one / both parents or anyone/both grandparents is (or was) / are (or were) citizen(s) of India by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of India or Section 2(b) of Citizenship Act 1955 (Act No. 57 of 1955).
- An FN is a person having citizenship of a foreign country and not having the status NRI and/ or PIO.
- Included as 15% of overall sanctioned intake.
- ** Over and above the approved intake of the seats for a particular programme. As notified by UGC vide D.O.No.1-1/2022(CPP-II), dated 30-09-2022(Point No.3). An FN is a person having citizenship of a foreign country (country other than India) and not having the status of 'NRI' and or 'PIO'.
